Wind power is the future. It is clean, non-polluting, renewable, and the cost to produce the electricity is not affected by fuel price increases or supply disruptions. Best of all,

twenty 1.5-megawatt wind turbines are now fully operational and will provide, on average, enough energy to power approximately 11,000 Maui homes.

The conversion of wind energy to electricity by Kaheawa Wind Power means Maui will import approximately *244,000 fewer barrels of oil per year*. With oil at about \$75 a barrel, this translates to savings of over \$18 million in imported fuel costs in the first year alone.
